On Saturday, July 29, 2023, I was at the White Deer Rodeo and concert. At approximately 11:40 pm, I was standing in the secured area behind the stage with Chief Deputy JC Blackburn.

We were notified of a medical north of our location near the dance floor. I walked to the location and observed a female on the ground. Captain Richardson was there and bystanders were attending to the victim, who appeared to be conscious and breathing but somewhat disoriented. According to information on the page from dispatch, the victim had a seizure. I radioed dispatch and instructed them to advise the ambulance to approach through the south gate, which is west of the stage. The rodeo grounds were very crowded with a conservative estimate of 3,500 persons present. All roads into the grounds were lined with parked vehicles.

I left the scene and went to Gladiola St., the street leading to the south gate, to ensure the road was open. I waited there until White Deer EMS arrived. While I was waiting, Kimberly Thomas who is with White Deer EMS walked up from the crowd and asked where the call was. I pointed them in the right direction and told them that a Deputy (Captain Richardson) was there with a flashlight on. Kimberly Thomas headed off in that direction.

I later learned that another White Deer EMT, John Thomas, had arrived on the scene from the crowd. White Deer EMS arrived at 11:50 pm with White Deer EMS Director Kassie Heagan and attendant Erik Winters as the crew. While they walked into the scene, I remained with the ambulance to keep it secure and to keep the road open. The ambulance crew came out of the crowd with the patient on their cot in approximately 5 to 8 minutes. They loaded the patient into the ambulance and continued treatment.

Jacob Clifton who is a supervisor with Gray County EMS was also at the ambulance and he asked me if I was aware of what was going on over there and he pointed at the scene. I answered, "No, what are you talking about?" Clifton stated that two of my Deputies put Congressman Ronny Jackson on the ground, handcuffed him and walked him out the gate. Clifton added that, to their credit, the Deputies asked Jackson to step back at least four times before they detained him. After writing this, I called Jacob Clifton and read it to him to be sure

that my recollection was complete. He stated that my account was accurate and he also added that he heard what Jackson said to Trooper Young.

Shortly after, I received a call from a White Deer Riding Club member who stated that I was needed at the north gate. He said that he did not know what was going on, but that I should get over there. I told him that I would be there as soon as we got the ambulance out of the rodeo grounds. In a few minutes the ambulance was ready to depart and we backed them down Gladiola Street until they could turn south on Daffodil Street. The ambulance exited the area on that street.

I walked to the north gate and was met by Chief Deputy Blackburn. A black SUV which I later learned contained Jackson's party was pulling away as I arrived. Blackburn told me that DPS Trooper Young had asked people to step back and give EMS room to work. While doing so he encountered Mr. Jackson who did not comply with the Trooper Young's instructions and a confrontation occurred. Blackburn told me that Jackson was very angry and was aggressive toward Young. He stated that after being asked to step back multiple times, Jackson aggressively advanced toward Young and Deputy Daniels. Deputy Alexander stepped between them to deescalate the situation. When Jackson did not comply the two Deputies put him on the ground and detained him with handcuffs. Blackburn stated that he arrived at about that time and they walked Jackson out the north gate and removed the handcuffs.

Trooper Young followed, and Jackson yelled and tried to get to Trooper Young several more times. Blackburn told me that Jackson was "motherfucking everyone" and threatened to "beat Young's ass." Blackburn said with some effort he got Jackson to enter the car and it left.

We got another medical page at 12:05 am (Sunday) that an ambulance was needed near the Lions Club burrito stand. I walked to that location and assisted EMS in loading another patient. At 12:25 am, I received a text from dispatch that read "Congressman Ronnie Jackson wants a phone call tonight referencing something that happened at the rodeo. Would not give details, just that he expects a call tonight." There was a phone number included in the text.

I walked to my vehicle and returned the call at 12:31 am. Congressman Jackson answered. He was very mad. He explained that he was a board-certified emergency physician and had been summoned to assist with a medical emergency. He also said a Trooper pulled him off the patient and that two of my Deputies threw him on the ground, held him down, handcuffed him and perp walked him out of the area in front of every video camera on the grounds.

Jackson stated that the patient was conscious and somewhat alert, and that a nurse helping thought the patient might be hypoglycemic and wanted to put something in her mouth that would elevate her blood sugar. Jackson said that he had told the other person that would be ok, that it might help, and that other people on the scene said, do not do that she has been seizing, and an argument followed. Jackson told me several times that the patient was stable and not in

distress, and that putting what was later described as a gumball in her mouth would not have presented a problem. He stated several times that he was “fucking pissed” about the whole situation.

I explained that I did not have all the details, but I did know that if my Deputies saw a Trooper that needed help, they would not hesitate to lend the Trooper assistance. Jackson stated that the Deputies used bad judgment, that the situation needed to be investigated, and that there better be consequences. Jackson also told me that he expected to know what the consequences were, and that they better be appropriate.

At the time of this conversation, I needed to be certain of the details and keep an open mind. I did tell him that I would investigate the details and take whatever action, if any, was needed. I also told him I did not need to be threatened. He stated that he was not threatening me, but that in the next election he would pull hell and high water and come and “bury me in the next election.”

He ended the conversation with the statement “Game on.”

Since I did not have my phone on speaker, the conversation was not recorded on my dash cam, but I used my county phone and recorded my recollection of the conversation. I made the recording immediately after hanging up.

We had several other incidents during and after the rodeo and I ended my involvement at 3:09 am.

When I arrived at work on Monday, Deputy Daniels and Deputy Alexander had submitted their reports. I reviewed them and contacted Texas Ranger Scott Swick. He was busy and said he would call back. I had Chief Deputy Blackburn contact him later, and he explained the situation and asked Ranger Swick to review the incident to determine if my Deputies took any inappropriate action. Ranger Swick said that he would have to check with his command and would get back to us.

We later heard back from Ranger Swick. He told us that his command said he should review the DPS body and dash cam and then render an opinion on the officer’s actions. On Tuesday, Ranger Swick called and reported that he had reviewed the dash cam and, that under the circumstances, the actions of the Deputies were appropriate and necessary. He indicated that we could request a copy of the video, but I declined to make that request at the time. I may request a copy of it later.

I had spoken with DPS Major Rippee earlier who advised that I could view the video at the Borger DPS office. Chief Deputy Blackburn and I drove to Borger and contacted Sgt. Dawson

who played the video for us. The video is being released and should be available for viewing elsewhere. I do not possess a copy of the video at this time, so I cannot share it. The one thing that struck me about the video is that most of the interaction with Jackson occurred as the ambulance crew was loading the patient. It seems that if the goal was to care for the patient, the aggressive activity from Jackson should have subsided once she was in the care of EMS. The video clearly shows that the aggressive behavior continued well after he was unrestrained.

On Tuesday 08/01/23 I received a text message from Kimberly Thomas which read: *Tam, Ronny Jackson is not licensed in Texas. He did appear drunk. His wife "the nurse" was worried about the girl's blood pressure while she was seizing instead of her airway. When the lady with dark hair kept trying to shove gum in the girl's mouth, we asked the officers to get them back. The dark-haired lady was drunk and laying on the girl with all her weight while the girl was seizing. We had no choice because the scene was not safe, and the patient was not safe. I am sorry if I did something wrong. I heard a guy say he was a doctor but we were already leaving, and he was chest bumping the Trooper at the time. He never came to the ambulance, so we continued with care.*

I received a phone call on Wednesday from Deputy Alexander who told me that she had forgotten to pass on a name of a witness who said they would make a statement. I passed the name on to Deputy Rocha for follow up. I received a call from Linda Shouse who identified herself as the nurse that cared for the victim at the scene. Shouse stated that she had expected to be contacted by Law Enforcement, and that she wanted to make a statement. We made an appointment to meet at the LEC at 3:00 pm on Thursday 08/03. (Deputy Rocha later reported that the witness would rather not make a statement and Shouse did not show up for our appointment.)

On Wednesday evening, I texted with Kimberly Thomas.

Sheriff – If you do not mind, I am going to use your text from yesterday in my report.

Thomas – Yes sir that is fine. They are posting everywhere that they are suing all of us.

I had asked Kimberly Thomas if putting something in a patient's mouth was against their protocols. *Thomas – Correct and holding on her back during a seizure is a definite no. Also, Dustin rolled her onto her side. We did not have a blood pressure cuff on her until the truck. That was the nurse worried about blood pressure. We only cared about air way until truck got there. The dad Jamie is singing their praise now also. And most gum is sugar free and is not going to anything but cause choking.*

Sheriff – Thanks. Did you and John walk up together?

Thomas – I kind of wish we would not have responded now.

Sheriff - I understand. I remember when you came by me, but do not remember if John was with you.

Thomas – Please apologize to the Trooper and Officers for me. I appreciate what they did but did not want this kind of PR for any of them. They do not deserve any of this. The Trooper was especially concerned for the young lady.

Sheriff – I will.

Thomas – They were ahead of me. Dustin came through the gate in front I think I went around because I thought it was closer to stage.

Sheriff – Thanks.

In summary, what started out as a routine medical turned into a mess because it occurred in a very loud and crowded environment. The Trooper and Deputies did not know who the nurse was and certainly did not know who Ronny Jackson was or that he was a physician. The first White Deer EMS personnel on the scene (Kimberly and John Thomas) did not know the nurse or Jackson, plus the Thomas's were not in any kind of uniform so they were not recognized by the nurse or Jackson as EMS. Under normal circumstances in White Deer everyone knows Kimberly and John and that they are associated with the ambulance. Not so at the scene on Saturday night.

So, it became a contest of who oversees the patient's care. One thing for sure is everyone present knew that the Trooper was a Trooper, and everyone should have complied with his commands no matter the circumstances. Also, the two Deputies on the scene were in uniform and recognizable, and their efforts to de-escalate the situation were ignored (even after the patient was taken to the ambulance) to the point that they felt the need to take action to control the situation.

After reading their reports and viewing the Trooper's body cam I agree with Ranger Swick that the Officers actions were justified.

Incident

On 7/29/2023 Deputies were working at the White Deer Rodeo. After the Rodeo event there was a concert at the grounds. At around 23:40 Deputies and EMS were dispatched to a down individual on the north side of the dance floor having a seizure. I remained behind the stage where we were going to direct the ambulance. The ambulance arrived and went to the scene of the down patient. A short time later I received a phone call from Capt. Richardson that Congressman Ronny Jackson had been detained over by this medical call.

On my arrival to the scene Congressman Jackson was in handcuffs screaming at the officers and yelling. I learned that he had been detained for asking to back away from the scene and refusing to comply w/ the Deputies and Trooper present. Congressman Jackson was demanding to be taken out of handcuffs and yelling profanity. Deputies told me that he had been put onto the ground and handcuffed by Deputy Daniels and Deputy Alexander due to his irate behavior and refusal to comply w/ commands given by them and Trooper Young.

Congressman Jackson was escorted out the front gate where our patrol units where by myself and other deputies. During this time Congressman Jackson was demanding to be taken out of handcuffs and screaming profanity about the trooper. Once at the gate I attempted to calm Congressman Jackson down and instructed deputies to take him out of handcuffs. I also told members of his party to get their vehicle so they could leave. Once out of handcuffs I began trying to calm Congressman Jackson down. As we were waiting Congressman Jackson saw Trooper Young as he was walking up behind his patrol unit and began yelling again. I physically had to hold Congressman Jackson back from going towards Trooper Young. Congressman Jackson continued to yell profanity at Trooper Young as he walked over to speak w/ Congressman Jackson. As Congressman Jackson continued to yell at Trooper Young once he walked over there. Trooper Young made an attempt to explain to Congressman Jackson why he had been asked to get back but this just seemed to get Congressman Jackson more agitated. I stepped back between them and told Jackson several times to get into his vehicle which was now pulled over by the front gate. Congressman Jackson continued even threatening the Trooper. I eventually physically pushed him around to the passenger side of their vehicle. While doing this Congressman Jackson was pushing back leaning his body into me and still yelling. I finally got him around to the passenger side where his party had the front door open for him. I told him to get into the vehicle which he did. Congressman Jackson continued to yell and scream from inside the vehicle about who he was. Congressman Jackson also stated that he was going to call Governor Abbott.

Once Jackson was inside the vehicle, I went to inform Sheriff Terry, who was walking towards our location, of what had taken place. After this I spoke w/ the deputies and Trooper Young. They stated that Jackson had been asked to step away from the patient by EMS so that they could tend to their patient. Jackson became belligerent and began yelling about him being a doctor. Deputies and Trooper Young stated that they did not know who he was and just knew that he had been asked to step back. Trooper Young asked me if I thought he was intoxicated. I told them that I knew he had been drinking

alcohol due to he was backstage earlier in the evening drinking alcohol while I was working security in that area.

Deputies also informed me that after I walked off to speak w/ Sheriff Terry Congressman Jackson got out of the vehicle again yelling at the deputies for their badge numbers and names. Deputies stated they provided this information.

Incident Review

I was informed my Sheriff Terry that he had made contact w/ Congressman Jackson per his request on 7/30/2023 in reference to this incident. During this conversation Congressman Jackson alleged misconduct on the part of the Deputies involved. I instructed the deputies involved w/ the incident to do a report on this for review.

On Monday Sheriff Terry informed me that he had reached out to Ranger Swick in reference to this case for an outside review. Ranger Swick later contacted me where I informed him of the situation and allegations. I also informed Ranger Swick that we did not have any camera footage, however the Trooper involved did have a body camera. Ranger Swick stated that he would get back w/ me.

Ranger Swick later contacted me and informed me that he would review the camera footage and give an opinion to the misconduct allegations. On Tuesday Ranger Swick reported back that he had reviewed the camera footage and stated that their opinion was there was not any misconduct w/ the information they had received.

Sheriff Terry also stated that that he had spoken w/ DPS who had informed us we could view a copy of the video at Sgt. Dawson's office in Borger Tx. Myself and Sheriff Terry went and viewed the video. There was not audio during the detention of Jackson, but it was obvious that he was agitated prior to the detention. I saw nothing that would lead me to believe that the deputies acted inappropriate for the situation and the environment. It is obvious from the length of the video that Jackson was not immediately detained on arrival by the Trooper or Deputies. It appeared that Deputies were only forced to detain Jackson after he would not calm down or comply w/ commands. This is also very consistent with the behavior that I witnessed over by the main gate after Jackson was escorted away.

After reviewing all information available to me I believe that the Deputies acted appropriate and were not excessive in their actions.

On July 30 2023 I was asked by Trooper Young to call for an ambulance to a medical at the rodeo grounds. Upon arrival between the concert stage and the merchandise booth, I noticed a young female laying on the ground. People were huddled around her. Someone had placed bottles of cold water on each side of her neck. While waiting for the ambulance to arrive, I noticed that the crowd huddled around the scene started to grow. Once EMS arrived on scene, they asked us to clear the crowd so that they could attend to the patient. I saw Trooper Young ask the man who was identified later as Ronnie Jackson to back up and give them room to work. Trooper Young stood between Jackson and the patient. I saw Jackson become irate, screaming repeatedly, "Do you know who I am? I'm an ER Doctor. " When Trooper young explained that EMS requested the crowd to back up, Jackson replied that he was an ER doctor and that they work for him. I turned away to help EMS load the patient, and grabbed the corner of the cot to assist with the removal due to the uneven terrain.

As we started to walk towards the back gate, I heard a loud sound behind me, and turned to see Ronnie Jackson on the ground, with Deputy Colton Daniels and Deputy China Alexander placing him in handcuffs. Jackson was screaming at the officers asking them if they knew who he was. Once Jackson was detained, I called Chief Deputy JC Blackburn to advise him of the incident. Chief Deputy Blackburn arrived on scene to try to talk with Jackson. Jackson was screaming saying "Do you know who the f██ I am? Get these f██g handcuffs off of me." Jackson was escorted away from dance floor area to our patrol cars where we removed the handcuffs. Jackson was still screaming profanity as we were removing the handcuff. Again, Chief Deputy Blackburn tried to reason with Jackson, but once Jackson saw Trooper Young again, he focused all his attention on him yelling "F██ you mother f██r!" During this ordeal, Jackson told Trooper Young that he just committed carrier suicide. Jackson demanded the name and badge number from Trooper Young. Jackson demanded an apology from Trooper Young. Trooper Young tried to explain his actions to Jackson, but Jackson would not hear it. Shortly after Jackson was released from handcuffs, his vehicle arrived. Chief Deputy Blackburn walked Jackson to his vehicle trying to stay between Jackson and Trooper Young. Once inside the vehicle, Jackson continues to yell at Trooper Young saying "F██ you motherf██r" Jackson was also flipping Trooper Young off from inside of his vehicle, while the driver was taking names and badge numbers of officers on scene. At that point I left the area.

Nothing further at this time.

INCIDENT/TYPE: SUPPLEMENT

SUSPECT: RONNY JACKSON 5/04/1967

SUPPLEMENT:

On 07/29/2023 at approximately 2348 hours, I (Carson County Deputy Alexander) arrived to a medical call on a 15-year-old female having seizures. When I approached the scene, I saw Deputy Daniels shining light on the patient who had two females and two males around her. I then walked south to help light the way for EMS who had arrived on scene.

Once we were back with the patient, I observed a W/F yelling at another W/F to back off and leave the patient alone. W/F #2 was removing something dark from the patient's mouth during this time. These requests quickly became commands from W/F #1. I then asked W/F #2 to step back at the request of W/F #1. Who I had believed to be the patients family member. After asking a few times I then placed my hand on W/F #2 shoulder and told her to step away. At this time W/F #2 stated the patient was her niece and she was assessing her, I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming off her person. W/F #2 attempted to approach the patient again and I put my hand up, placing my fingertips on her chest and stated she needed to stay back. W/F #2 then asked if she could tell me something but I heard commotion to the right of me and re-directed my attention.

I heard Trooper Young begin to give commands to a W/M in a maroon shirt later identified as (Ronny Jackson). Trooper Young yelled for Jackson to back up with his hand on Jacksons chest moving him backwards. I then turned my body where I was standing next to Deputy Daniels in front of Jackson. Jackson had become irate and was screaming obscenities. Jackson was screaming "F███K YOU," "F███K THAT MOTHER F███R," "I'M A F███G ER DOCTOR," continuously and while pointing at Trooper Young screamed "I'M GOING TO BEAT THAT MOTHER F███RS' A███!" Jackson was bright red, his eyes were bulging, and he was close enough to my face that I could feel the spit coming out of his mouth landing on my face. Jackson was going back and forth from Deputy Daniels and I during this outburst to try to get to Trooper Young. I told Jackson not to make threats, Jackson attempted to push through Deputy Daniels and I. Deputy Daniels and I continued to attempt to calm Jackson down verbally by asking him to calm down. Jackson was adamant on getting to Trooper Young, Jackson then attempted to push through Deputy Daniels and I again. After this attempt I grabbed Jacksons arm and he jerked it away from me. Jackson screamed "COME HERE!" and attempted with greater force to push through Deputy Daniels and I to get to Trooper Young. Deputy Daniels and I used Jacksons momentum to take him down to the ground.

Once to the ground I went to the right side of Jackson who was on his chest. I placed my hand on the cheek of Jacksons face to maintain control until Jackson was placed in handcuffs. Jackson was laying on his right arm so I asked multiple times to move his arm from underneath him. Jackson was continuing to scream "GET THESE F███KING CUFFS OFF ME," "GET THE F███K OFF ME." Jackson then complied and pulled his hand out from underneath him. I handed his hand to Deputy Daniels who placed Jackson in handcuffs. Deputy Daniels and I then picked Jackson off the ground; this is when Chief Deputy Blackburn arrived. Deputy Daniels and Chief

Deputy Blackburn then walked Jackson to the main entrance where all our patrol units were parked. While walking Jackson continued to scream, "I WANT THAT TROOPERS INFORMATION," "F███K HIM F███K YOU."

When we got to the outside of the rodeo gates the handcuffs were removed from Jackson. I then saw Trooper Young walking up to the back of his patrol unit with several people following. I approached Trooper Young to attempt to control the crowd that was beginning to grow. I requested everyone stay back until the situation was under control. This is when a W/F with Jackson's party later identified as his wife approached Trooper Young demanding his information. I then asked the W/F to please give him a second and that we would give her his information. Trooper Young then made contact with Jackson in attempts to calm him and explain himself. Due to Jacksons agitated stated he was beyond the point of comprehension, Jackson continued screaming at Trooper Young. Chief Deputy Blackburn then stepped in between Jackson and Trooper Young to de-escalate the situation. Jacksons wife then aggressively pointed at me and screamed "SHE PUT HIM IN HANDCUFFS!" I heard a female voice scream "CALL THE GOVERNOR!" but was unable to tell who in their party it came from. Jackson had to be physical pushed by Chief Deputy Blackburn to the passenger side of Jacksons vehicle. Chief Deputy Blackburn finally got Jackson to get into the passenger seat of a SUV; Jackson continued to scream and flip us off. Jacksons wife then approached Trooper Young and requested his information after giving it to her she asked me for mine, I provided the information. A young W/M with Jacksons party apologized for the actions that were just displayed and a W/F stated "be ready this is about to blow up." All members of the party the entered the SUV and left.

My body camera was not activated during this time due to the nature of the original call.

DEPUTY ALEXANDER 719

On 07/29/2023 I Carson County Sheriff's Office Deputy Colton Daniels was patrolling the Rodeo Grounds when I was advised by the event staff that there is a young female having a seizure by the west fence, between the stage and the dance floor.

Upon arrival, I noticed a white female laying in the recovery position with multiple people standing around her. At that time, I was advised by CCSO Captain Chris Richardson that EMS are enroute and that she appears to be doing ok. As I was standing by, I was attempting to keep the crowds of people away from the patient so the Event staff and others can help the patient. Once EMS arrived on scene at the gate, I then heard several people start yelling at a female who was with the patient on the ground, who attempted to put something in patient's mouth. At that time, the Event staff and other people around the patient then demanded both the female and the male that were near the patient to back off. At this time, we then attempted to start moving everyone away from the patient. As we were moving everyone back, I then noticed Texas Department of Public Safety Trooper Cade Young yelling at the male subject later identified as Ronny Jackson to get back. Trooper young then yelled at Jackson for the second time to get back and Young then placed his right hand on Jacksons chest to push him back. Jackson then became agitated and started screaming "Do you know who the f*** I am" and "I am a f***ing ER Doctor". At that time, I then got in front of Jackson to try and calm him down. Jackson then began yelling at the Trooper "I'm gonna whoop that mother f***er's a**" and "F*** you". As Jackson continued to cuss, I continued to back Jackson away from the trooper so that there would be no more issues. Jackson appeared to be so agitated that he would not listen to me or my partner who was just trying to calm him down. Jackson continued to not listen to me and then Jackson stated "come here" to the trooper and then Jackson took an aggressive drive towards the trooper pushing past me and my partner. Once Jackson managed to push past me and my partner, I then grabbed Jackson arm and used his driving momentum to go to the ground. Once on the ground I then placed Jackson into handcuffs for the safety of himself and others due to his agitated state. Once in handcuffs CCSO Chief Deputy Blackburn arrived on scene and we escorted Jackson to the front gates. As we were escorting Jackson to the front gates Jackson stated "F*** that trooper", "I'm gonna have his f***ing job", and "I want that mother f***er's information". Jackson would not calm down and continued to be agitated towards the trooper all the way to the front gate.

Once at the front gate near our patrol units, Chief Deputy Blackburn then instructed me to remove the handcuffs. Once the handcuffs were taken off, Chief Deputy Blackburn then attempted to calm Jackson down. Jackson continued to be agitated at the front gate and then Trooper Young attempted to talk to Jackson and explain the situation. Jackson then became more agitated and then Blackburn got into the middle of both Jackson and Young to separate them. Once Blackburn got into the middle, Blackburn then had to place his hands on Jackson to push him away because Jackson continued to try and push past Blackburn to get to the trooper. Blackburn then walked Jackson to his vehicle. While Jackson was being escorted to his vehicle,

Jackson continued to yell at the trooper. Once Jackson was placed into the passenger seat of his car, Jackson then started yelling "F●k you" while showing us his middle finger.

After Jackson was placed into his car, Chief Deputy Blackburn walked away, and Jackson then got out of the vehicle and demanded to know who placed him in handcuffs. I then advised Jackson that I placed him in handcuffs due to his agitated state. Jackson then demanded my name and badge number. As I was giving Jackson my information, Jackson continued to yell in my face leaving him unable to comprehend that I have given him my information several times. Once Jackson got my information he then got into his vehicle and proceeded to yell at us again from inside the car.

Once Jackson was inside his vehicle, several of Jacksons friends apologized for the incident and one female stated "get ready for this to blow up". All parties then got into the SUV with Jackson and left the property.
